

## Why are the moms fighting against Common Core opposing John Diehl's re-election?

- For over two years these tireless women (and men) have been fighting to prevent the state from ceding their children's educational opportunities to out-of-state interests.
- Tens of thousands of Missourians and most legislators now agree that Missouri must reject Common Core and give control of education back to parents. Floor Leader John Diehl insisted that the bill to rein in Common Core (HB1490) be sent to conference committee where it was weakened.
- Parents are very concerned about schools collecting their children's personal data. The proposed legislation that would have effectively governed what information could be collected and who can access that information on the students was also blocked.
